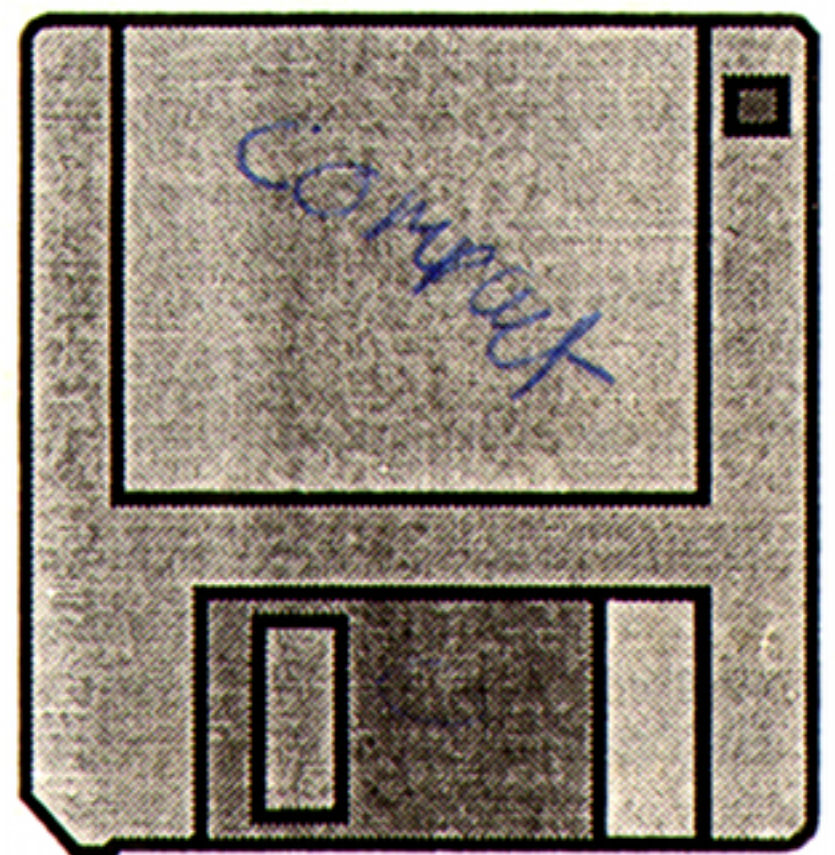

Welcome to the BBC PD 1993 summary catalogue.

This release is (was) fully up-to-date on 22 June, 1993. It summarises PD library discs 1 to 156, the Beebug early magazine discs and the John Lyons range of educational shareware, and details the non-PD software available from Fast Access and Disc User. Also summarised is the range of Master 512 software which was introduced in 1992 (detailed in full on the ADFS 'L' version of the 'Catalogue & Sampler' disc).

Bracketed numbers next to an item indicate the catalogue number and that software from other categories is also on that disc; unbracketed numbers indicate that that numbered disc is filled by just the software noted in the entry.

The Catalogue & Sampler Disc (disc number 0) contains fuller details of all of these (and later) discs, together with identification of authors, information about compatibility of the software with different models, disc formats and numbers required, etc. Sample software on the disc varies in accordance with disc space and changes from time to time to represent the most recent additions to the catalogue (so you can get a selection of the most recent software just by returning your catalogue disc, with an s.a.e, for updating ...) The disc also contains details of some limited availability commercial software products at special prices, so long as stock lasts.

John Lyons Educational Shareware

The software detailed on this page is all ex-commercial software, originally sold for £ 15.00 per copy by John Lyons Software. All of the software detailed below has been re-released as shareware. If you find it useful you are expected to pay a registration fee (to John Lyons). Registration costs £7.50 per package.

The titles are available individually on 40T DFS disc (in which case, please order by title), or for the majority of users, in sets of two on either DFS 80T d/s or ADFS'L' format disc (in which case, please order by disc number as indicated). Combinations of two titles of your own choice are **not** possible on one disc. The cost is as the rest of the library (£1.50/£1.75 per disc). Some further details are held in a separate catalogue file on some formats of the **Catalogue & Sampler Disc**

A Plea.

If I let it, BBC PD would run my entire life. I have enjoyed the three years or so of running the library, but admit that this edition of the catalogue nearly didn't make it into existence. I have decided after a lot of thought to make the following explicit limitations to what it is possible for me to do: Hopefully, this will improve the usefulness of the library to the majority of users and take BBC PD back to its origins as a PD library, but it will limit some of the more time-consuming activities I have been involved in over the last year. With the library having thousands of users to date, it is impossible for me to continue to put the necessary amount of effort into replying to some requests, as this can only be to the detriment of others.

BBC PD will fulfil its functions as a PD / Shareware library - complete orders as speedily as possible (usually by first class post the day after receipt of your order), and guarantees to replace at no cost to you any faulty disc or disc incorrectly sent to you (e.g. containing software other than that described in the catalogue for the item you ordered)..

BBC PD can not

- Guarantee that any particular software will be exactly what you want (It should conform to the catalogue description, though)
- Modify software to suit your own personal requirements
- Prepare additional documentation for PD software to clarify unclear points for you (although I will always try to persuade submitters of software to properly document their work).
- Swap discs you have previously ordered for other items in the library
- Provide a message-passing service to software authors unless this has been explicitly agreed
- Provide advice on which printer (modem, other peripheral) would best suit your needs
- Provide training or guidance on aspects of the use of your computer on an individual basis
- Give guidance on programming techniques you may be interested in
- Diagnose software or hardware problems
- Arrange for software to be written to your request
- Teach you how to use your computer. (I am sorry about this, as there are still a number of new users who don't have the benefits of lots of magazine coverage to help them. Does anyone want to write a 'newcomers guide to the BBC'? - distribution guaranteed!)
- Obtain commercial software packages on your behalf
- Photocopy software manuals to go with your pirated software (I am amazed that some people have the nerve to ask!), or
- Pirate the software for you in the first place!

Please don't see the length of the 'can not' list as a negative approach - it is intended to be a positive move to ensure that I don't get bogged down and you don't become disappointed with a slow response to correspondence which I don't have the resources to help with. The choice was getting to be that, or close down BBC PD, a thing I really didn't want to do given the ever-decreasing sources of support for the BBC Micro these days

FAST ACCESS VOLUME 1

FAST ACCESS is a disc-based, subscription only, bi-monthly magazine for the BBC Micro (&co.). It was originally published by Argus Specialist Press, following the close down of DISC USER. It is still going strong, and each issue contains a varied selection of software, demos, of commercial software, tutorial material, graphic images, etc.. Currently, FAST ACCESS is up to Volume 3. A subscription to volume 1 originally cost £46 for 1 year (6 issues).

BBC PD is very pleased to announce the availability at 'Public Domain' prices of all 6 issues of Volume One of **FAST ACCESS**.

Each issue of Volume 1 consists of 2 x 40T (DFS, 5.25") discs with a mix of software. One improvement (so far as disc distribution is concerned) of FAST ACCESS over the old DISC USER is that most of the programs are accompanied by detailed text files on disc. However, BBC PD is able to provide each issue exactly as it was supplied to subscribers, with 20 sides of printed reference text and notes per issue.

Each issue consists of 2 x 40T discs, 20 sides of printed text and a disc mailer.
COSTS: £3.00 per issue, or £15.00 for all six issues when bought together.
(Inclusive of postage, etc.)

BBC PD has received permission from the copyright holders, **Argus Specialist Press**, to distribute copies of the software originally published with the (now defunct) **DISK USER** magazine. **DISK USER** consisted of a thin magazine and a single, 40T (DFS), disk of software; the main purpose of the magazine was to support the software on the disk. Fourteen issues were produced in all.

Many issues come with documentation on disc, provided by contributors to BBC PD; this is in addition to any documentation provided on disc with the original magazine and is intended to help prevent any problems caused by lack of the original magazines themselves (These could not be reproduced in any case for copyright reasons). Some issues are not yet documented in this way, and the submissions promised are now so overdue it is unlikely that they will ever arrive (unless someone else volunteers?).

The contents of each issue are summarised below : the summaries are not exhaustive. In particular, there was a series of MODE 7 graphic animations by artist ABBAS, illustrating the letters of the alphabet, which appeared as one or two animations per issue.

The catalogue numbers indicated in this summary generally indicate that software fills one DFS 80T double-sided disc, or one ADFS 80T disc as appropriate. Obviously, more discs of a lower capacity will be required to hold the same software. Further details are included in the full catalogue and on the back of the order form. All Acorn disc formats can be catered for, but non-standard formats (such as DDFS formats) cannot be handled. If you use a BBC Model 'B' or 'B+', it is recommended that you order DFS rather than ADFS discs.

SUBMISSIONS
